FROM GRAND CENTRAL TERMINAL

Flushing Subway World's Fair Express direct to Fair Grounds. Running time approximately 25 minutes. Fare: 5c.

FROM PENNSYLVANIA STATION

Long Island Railroad trains direct to Fair Grounds. Running time 10 minutes. Fare: 10c.

FROM TIMES SQUARE

Flushing Subway World's Fair Express direct to Fair Grounds. Running time approximately 30 minutes. Fare: 5c.

INDEPENDENT Subway System — 8th Ave.

Direct line from stations in Midtown area direct to Amusement Section of Fair. Running time from 42nd St. and 8th Ave. approximately 40 minutes. Fare: 5c.

BASEBALL — At the Polo Grounds — Yankee Stadium — Ebbett's Field.

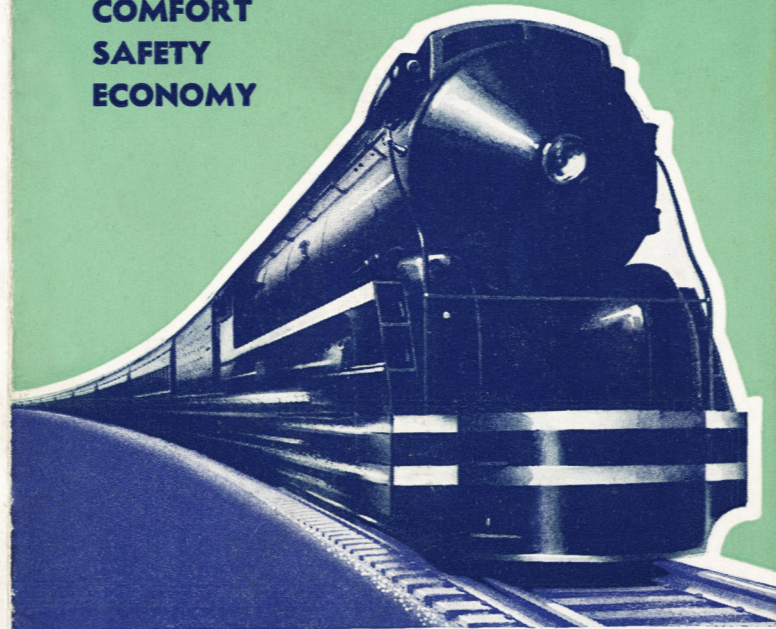

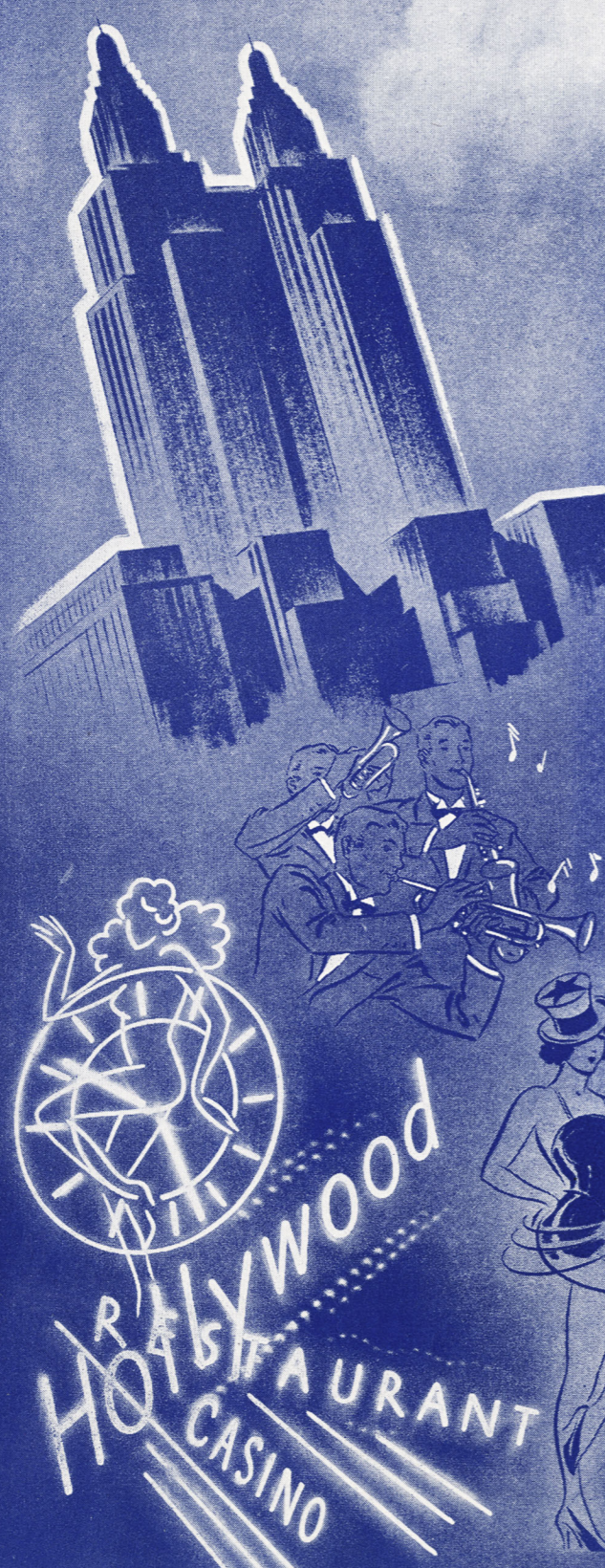

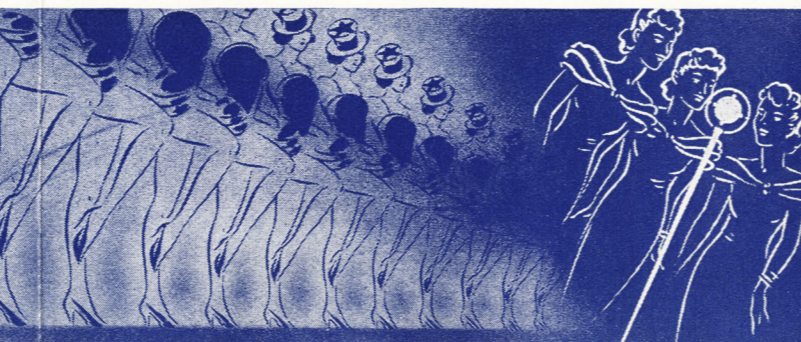
