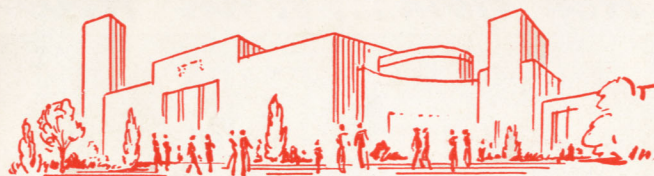

Where a hotel is listed in more than one group, superior accommodations will be provided when the rate for the higher group is paid.

At hotels under De Luxe, Group 1 and Group 2 double room prices include room with double bed or twin beds, as preferred. At hotels under Group 3 and Group 4, although double room prices are based on rooms with double beds, in some cases twin beds will be provided at no extra cost. In other cases twin beds, if desired, will be provided at a small extra charge, this to be paid direct to the hotel.



General Information

Individual Service: These services are for individuals and are therefore unescorted. You are free to enjoy the World's Fair, the sights of New York and the features of these arrangements at your own convenience.

Special Rates for Children: No charge will be made for children under 5 years of age, sharing bed in hotel with adult. Children under 3 years of age will be admitted free to the Exposition and no charge will be made for transfers specified in the itineraries, nor for sightseeing, unless child occupies a separate seat in the sightseeing coach.

For children 5 to 12 years of age sharing hotel room with adults, the rate will be as follows:

Example 1: One adult accompanied by one child 5 to 12 years of age will be charged Single Room rate—child charged one-half Single Room rate.

Example 2: Two adults accompanied by child 5 to 12 years of age will be charged Double Room rate each—child charged one-half Double Room rate.

Meals are not included in these arrangements, except at Billy Rose's Diamond Horseshoe as specified in the 6-Day and 7-Day Tours.

Sightseeing: The World's Fair Tour by Guide Chair starts from the American Express Tour Booth near Long Island Railroad Fair Entrance.

The Grand Sightseeing Tour of New York will be made by comfortable Gray Line Motor Coach.

National Broadcasting Company Studio Tour may be made, or Rockefeller Center Observation Roof visited at Radio City, 30 Rockefeller Plaza.

Hudson River Day Line New York Harbor Cruise or Trip to West Point or Newburg (included in 6-Day and 7-Day Tours only) depart from foot of West 42nd Street daily.

The above services are available on any day. For further information concerning schedules of the above trips consult the clerk at the hotel at which you are stopping.

Transfers: Transfer from station to hotel in New York will be performed by the TERMINAL SYSTEM Taxicabs.

Extension of Visit: If you desire to stay at your hotel for a period longer than that specified in your arrangements, you must notify the hotel management.

American Express Travel Service: These arrangements in New York will be under the auspices of the American Express, a world-wide organization internationally-known for its travel service and travelers cheques.

During the World's Fair, the American Express Company will maintain a Special World's Fair Unit at 65 Broadway, also service and information bureaus at all New York railroad terminals and an exhibit office in the Communications Building within the World's Fair grounds.
