Individual Service: These services are for individuals and are therefore unescorted. You are free to enjoy the World's Fair, the sights of New York, and the features of these arrangements at your own convenience.

Special Rates for Children: No charge will be made for children under 5 years of age sharing bed in hotel with adult. Children under 5 years of age will be admitted free to the Exposition, and no charge will be made for transfers specified in the itineraries, nor for sightseeing unless child occupies a separate seat in the sightseeing coach.

For children 5 to 12 years of age sharing hotel room with adults, the rate will be as follows:

Example 1: One adult accompanied by one child 5 to 12 years of age will be charged Single Room ratechild charged one-half Single Room rate plus 50c. Example 2: Two adults accompanied by child 5 to 12 years of age will be charged Double Room rate each -child charged one-half Double Room rate plus 50c.

Meals are not included in these arrangements.






